Amy Nash Receives Academic Achievement Award

San Antonio, TX – Amy M. Nash was recognized for her outstanding academic achievement by The International Conference of Funeral Service Examining Boards at their recent annual convention that took place February 28-29, 2008. Out of over 1,400 students from across the country who sat for the arts section of the National Board Exam of The Conference in 2007, Nash made one of the two highest scores.
